WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) made funding available to the City of Dallas, under the FY 2024 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) to build our capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from a terrorist attack or natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2024, the City Council authorized the acceptance of the 2024 Homeland Security Grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency passed through the Texas Office of the Governor-Homeland Security Grants Division, which includes the Urban Area Security Initiative to provide funding for activities related to enhancing preparedness and building capacity to prepare for, prevent and respond to complex coordinated terrorist attacks for the period January 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026, by Resolution No. 24-1784; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2026, the Texas Office of the Governor added a new project, Grant No. 5853501, reallocated \$678,352.24 of unspent funds within the existing budget, and extended the period of performance of the City of Dallas FY2024 HSGP grant award - Federal/State Award ID No. EMW-2024-SS-05096; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas designates the Chief Financial Officer as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for operating expenses related to emergency preparedness and response activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will benefit from increased preparedness throughout the city and region.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to amend Resolution No. 24-1784, approved on December 11, 2024 for the grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency passed through the Texas Office of the Governor Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) for the FY 2024 Homeland Security Grant Program which includes the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) (Federal / State Award ID No. EMW-2024-SS-05096 in an amount not to exceed \$5,842,198.40 to: **(1)** add Grant No. 5853501 for additional activities related to enhancing preparedness and building capacity to prepare for, prevent, and respond to terrorist attacks; **(2)** extend the term of the agreement from August 31, 2026 to November 30, 2026; **(3)** reallocate \$678,352.24 within the existing budget, \$620,635.34 to Grant No. 5853501, \$57,716.90 to Grant No. 2980710; and **(4)** execution of the amended grant

agreement with HSGD and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the amended agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That all other requirements of Resolution No. 24-1784, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the Office of the Governor any expenditure identified as ineligible or in the event of loss of funds. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 4. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager or their designee is authorized to provide additional information, make adjustments, and take other actions related to the implementation or termination of the grant as may be necessary to satisfy the DHS and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

SECTION 6. That this contract is designated as Contract No. ECR-2025-00026284.

SECTION 7. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
