WHEREAS, on December 9, 2020, the City Council authorized a five-year service price agreement for integrated pest management services for citywide use at City facilities with Shamrock Pest Control, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$347,910 and Pest Management of Texas, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$1,500.00, in a total estimated amount of \$349,410, by Resolution No. 20-1911.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Seed Family Premier Services LLC dba Pestmaster of Plano & McKinney (VC0000035219), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for integrated pest management services for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$892,592.83. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Seed Family Premier Services LLC dba Pestmaster of Plano & McKinney shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Seed Family Premier Services LLC dba Pestmaster of Plano & McKinney under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$892,592.83 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Seed Family Premier Services LLC dba Pestmaster of Plano & McKinney from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2025-00028246.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
