**WHEREAS,** on October 28, 2020, the City Council authorized a contract with Schneider Electric Buildings Americas Inc. for on-site and remote monitoring, analysis, and support of building operating systems to improve and reduce operating costs at City facilities by Resolution No. 20-1675, through The Interlocal Purchasing System, Contract No. 19060401; and

**WHEREAS**, this action will authorize Change Order No. 1 to the contract with Schneider Electric Buildings Americas Inc. to increase the contract amount for on-site and remote monitoring analysis and support of building operating systems to improve and reduce operating costs at City facilities, in an amount not to exceed \$219,859.75, increasing the contract from \$879,439.00 to \$1,099,298.75.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That an increase to the contract with Schneider Electric Buildings Americas Inc. (Change Order No. 1) is authorized to increase the contract amount for on-site and remote monitoring analysis and support of building operating systems to improve and reduce operating costs at City facilities, in an amount not to exceed \$219,859.75, increasing the contract from \$879,439.00 to \$1,099,298.75, subject to annual appropriations.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$219,859.75 to Schneider Electric Buildings Americas Inc., as follows:
