WHEREAS, on April 26, 2023, the City Council authorized a three-year contract, for an endpoint detection and response solution with Netsync Network Solutions, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$873,104.50, by Resolution No. 23-0573; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2024, the City Council authorized a two-year upgrade for the endpoint detection and response solution with Netsync Network Solutions, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$949,746.80, by Resolution No. 24-0606.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Netsync Network Solutions, Inc. (VS0000067969) through the Texas Department of Information Resources cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for real-time threat monitoring and response service for all city computers and devices for the Department of Information and Technology Services for a term of three-years, in an amount not to exceed \$2,392,621.50. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to Netsync Network Solutions, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Netsync Network Solutions, Inc. under the cooperative purchasing agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,392,621.50 (subject to annual appropriations) to Netsync Network Solutions, Inc. from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DSV-2025-00028836.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
