WHEREAS, on June 23, 2021, the City Council authorized the construction services contract with Vescorp Construction, LLC dba Chavez Concrete Cutting for the construction of Montfort Drive from Interstate Highway 635 (IH 635) Frontage Road to Alpha Road in the amount of \$4,470,718.90 by Resolution No. 21-1095; and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize an increase in the construction services contract with Vescorp Construction, LLC dba Chavez Concrete Cutting for additional paving and drainage improvements needed to complete the construction of Monfort Drive from IH 635 Frontage Road to Alpha Road, in an amount not to exceed \$916,946.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,470,718.90 to \$5,387,664.90.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

Now, Therefore,

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Vescorp Construction, LLC dba Chavez Concrete Cutting (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for additional paving and drainage improvements needed to complete the construction of Monfort Drive from IH 635 Frontage Road to Alpha Road, in an amount not to exceed \$916,946.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,470,718.90 to \$5,387,664.90.

SECTION 2. That in order to reimburse and finance the authorized disbursements described herein from General Obligation bonds, the City intends to issue one or more commercial paper notes as part of its General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series 2017A, and Series 2017B, and use the proceeds thereof to reimburse the disbursements described herein.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$916,946.00 to Vescorp Construction, LLC dba Chavez Concrete Cutting from the Street and Transportation (A) Fund, Fund 1V22, Department PBW, Unit W330, Object 4510, Activity INGV, Program PB06W330, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-PBW-2021-00016409, Vendor VS89922.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
