WHEREAS, on January 22, 2020, the City Council authorized a three-year master agreement with, two one-year renewal options, for compressed natural gas for equipped fleet vehicles for the Department of Equipment and Fleet Management with Clean Energy, a California corporation, registered to do business in Texas as California Clean Energy, Inc. in an estimated amount of \$2,686,250.88, by Resolution No. 20-0212.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That a master agreement for the purchase of compressed natural gas for equipped fleet vehicles for the Department of Equipment and Fleet Management is authorized with Clean Energy, a California corporation, registered to do business in Texas as California Clean Energy, Inc. (VC14154), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$4,990,727.04. The amount payable pursuant to this master agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for compressed natural gas for equipped fleet vehicles for the Department of Equipment and Fleet Management. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases of compressed natural gas for equipped fleet vehicles for the Department of Equipment and Fleet Management under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$4,990,727.04, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to Clean Energy, a California corporation, registered to do business in Texas as California Clean Energy, Inc. from Master Agreement Contract No. EFM-2024-00024811.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
