WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas under the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division (CJD) for the Crime Laboratory Portal System-Firearms Grant, Grant No. 5661501 for the fiscal year 2026-2027; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division (CJD) for the Crime Laboratory Portal Records Program and the Crime Laboratory Portal System-Firearms Project (Grant No. 5661501, State Award ID No. 2026-LP-ST-0001) in the amount of \$40,000.00 to provide design and development of a custom Application Programming Interface that will enable the Omingo Dallas system to securely transfer crime laboratory records to the Texas Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory Records Portal for the period March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027; and execute the grant agreement with the CJD and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 in the CJD Crime Laboratory Portal Records Grant Fund, Fund S451, Department DPD, Unit 685D, Object 3070.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 in the CJD Crime Laboratory Portal Records Grant Fund, Fund S451, Department DPD, Unit 685D, Revenue Code 6516.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 from the CJD Crime Laboratory Portal Records Grant Fund, Fund S451, Department DPD, Unit 685D, Object 3070.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the CJD in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the CJD final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00030121.

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SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
