WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas for the FY25 Safer Outcomes: Enhancing De-Escalation and Crisis Response Training for Law Enforcement – Support for Law Enforcement Agencies Grant, 15JCOPS-25-GG-00839-DETX, Assistant Listing No. 16.710 for FY 2026 - 2027; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) for the FY25 Safer Outcomes: Enhancing De-Escalation and Crisis Response Training for Law Enforcement – Support for Law Enforcement Agencies (Federal Award ID. No. 15JCOPS-25-GG-00839-DETX, Assistant Listing No. 16.710) in the amount of \$500,000.00 to enhance de-escalation, crisis intervention, and force training programs for officers and support personnel at the Dallas Police Department; add a Senior Law Enforcement Training Specialist position for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2027; and execute the grant agreement with the DOJ and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 in the COPS FY25 Safer Outcomes LE Grant Fund, Fund F811, Department DPD, Unit 684R, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 in the COPS FY25 Safer Outcomes LE Grant Fund, Fund F811, Department DPD, Unit 684R, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 from the COPS FY25 Safer Outcomes LE Grant Fund, Fund F811, Department DPD, Unit 684R, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

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SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the DOJ in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the DOJ final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00029234.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
