

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Chapter 28, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," of the Dallas City Code by amending Sections 28-45 and 28-50; regulating vehicle speeds on certain expressways; designating school traffic zones; providing a penalty not to exceed \$200; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Subsection (a) Section 28-45, "Expressways and Freeways," of Division 2, "Speed Regulations," of Article VI, "Operation of Vehicles," of Chapter 28, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," of the Dallas City Code is amended by alphabetically adding and deleting the following described streets where the speed of motor vehicles is limited as follows:

SECTION 2. That Subsection (c) of Section 28-50, "Speed in School Zones; Signs; Designated Streets," of Division 2, "Speed Regulations," of Article VI, "Operation of Vehicles," of Chapter 28, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic," of the Dallas City Code is amended by alphabetically adding and deleting the following described streets designated as school traffic zones where the speed of motor vehicles is limited to 20 miles per hour:

SECTION 3. That a person violating a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200.00.

SECTION 4. That Chapter 28 of the Dallas City Code shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That any act done or right vested or accrued, or any proceeding, suit, or prosecution had or commenced in any action before the amendment or repeal of any ordinance, or part thereof, shall not be affected or impaired by amendment or repeal of any ordinance or part thereof, and shall be treated as still remaining in full force and effect for all intents and purposes as if the amended or repealed ordinance, or part thereof, had remained in force.

SECTION 6. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.
