WHEREAS, the President of the United States recently issued several executive orders and, as a result, federal agencies changed grant conditions to align with the executive orders, which may affect some city programs or policies; and

WHEREAS, because of the evolving federal directives, City Council must evaluate and review city programs and policies to determine whether any adjustments may be necessary; and

WHEREAS, because of the evolving federal directives and timing, without delegating any final policy-making authority, City Council finds it necessary to authorize the city manager to review city programs and policies for compliance with federal directives and, as necessary, to temporarily pause for operational purposes a policy or program to ensure compliance, and to bring to City Council any recommendations for final action.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is directed to review and evaluate city programs and policies to determine whether any adjustments may be necessary.

SECTION 2. That, without delegating any final policy-making authority, the City Manager is authorized to temporarily pause for operational purposes a city program or policy to ensure compliance with federal directives.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is directed to timely brief City Council on all temporarily paused city programs or policies and present recommendations for any proposed City Council final action.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately after its passage, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
