SUBJECT Committee Recommendation on the 3 Sisters Lakes Renaming Resolution

On June 9, 2025, the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee (Committee) received a briefing memorandum on the proposed renaming of the 3 Sisters Lakes, a series of lakes included in the planned West Dallas Lakes area as part of the construction of the Dallas Floodway Levee Raise and Flattening that provide opportunities to build on the implementation of the city's Balanced Vision Plan. The renaming would recognize the city's Native American history and honor the Native American tribes historically associated with the Dallas area and surrounding region.

A majority of the Committee voted to recommend that City Council authorize a resolution renaming the 3 Sisters Lakes: NámúNahmi Lake (Comanche Nahmi Lake), Wichita ita:i?h Lake, and Lipan Apache Mbátí Lake.

This memorandum provides the Committee's recommendation and request for placement of the item on the June 25, 2025, city council voting agenda.¹
