**A. COVID-19 Vaccine, Testing, and Data Updates**

**Action Taken/Committee Recommendation(s):** The region's health experts gave updates on COVID-19 vaccine, testing, and data efforts in the City of Dallas and Dallas County. The Committee members discussed and asked questions about the Dallas County COVID-19 risk level, demographic data regarding the rate of vaccinations, data about breakthrough infections resulting from the different COVID-19 variants, the City's role in COVID-19 testing and vaccine sites, and if new vaccination sites will be needed in the city particularly if the vaccine will be made available to children under 4 years of age.
