

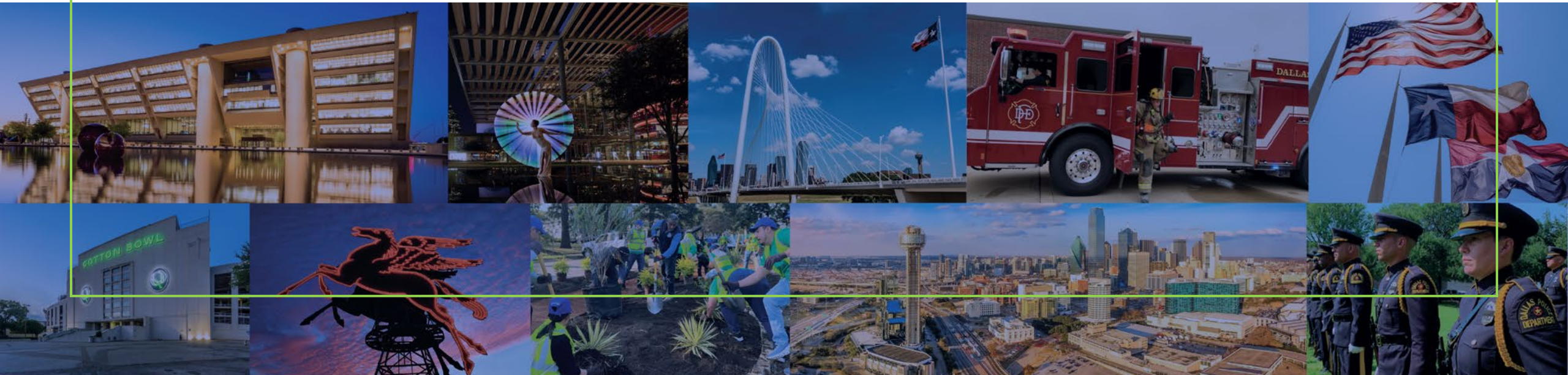

Background: *Summary of July*

Overall Violent Crime is down by **–8.78%** year-to-date.

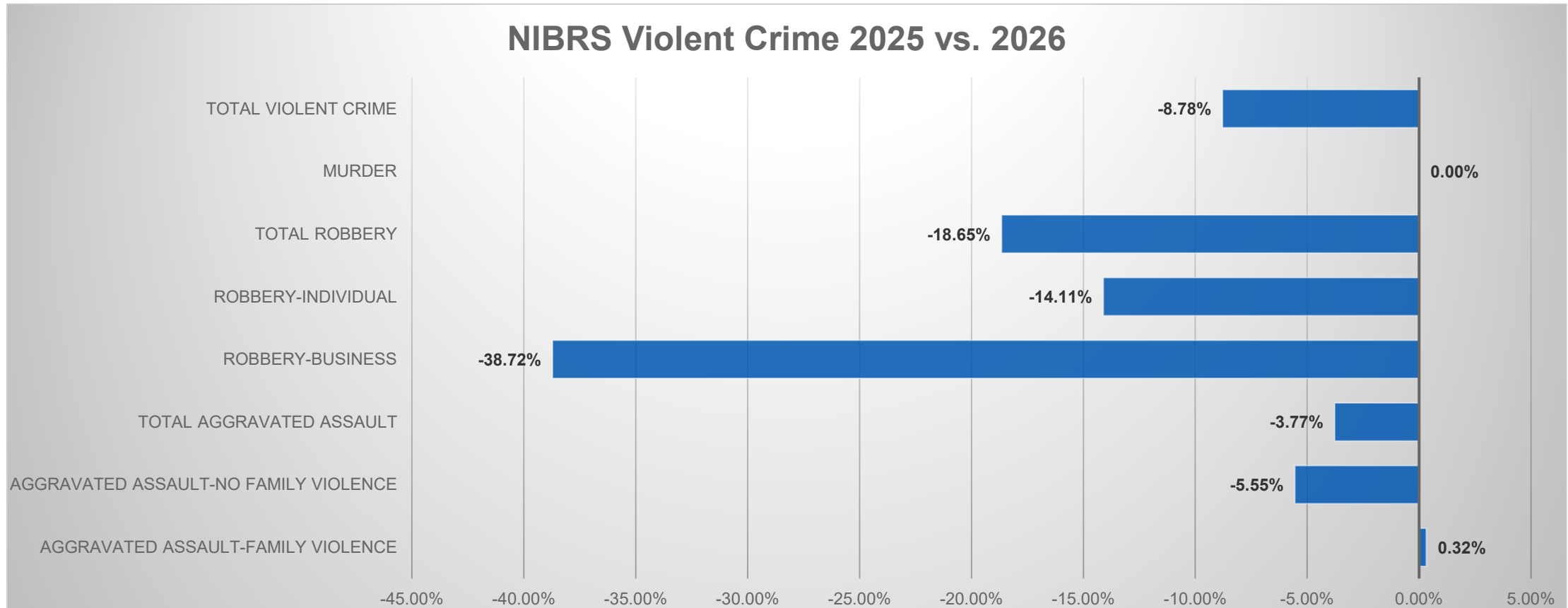
Several contributing factors as of YTD:

Operation Safe Streets - 724 total arrest.

Operation Uptown- Downtown – 725 total arrest

Robberies – 221 fewer victims

Murder

As of July 31, 2026, Non Family Violence Murders in Dallas have increased 8.57% **(6) more victims overall YTD.**

0 Murders involving FV.



Robbery

Overall robberies are down **-18.65%** YTD. **221 Fewer Victims.**

Business robberies are down **-38.72%** **(103)** and individual robberies are down **-14.11%** **(129)** as of July 31, 2026.

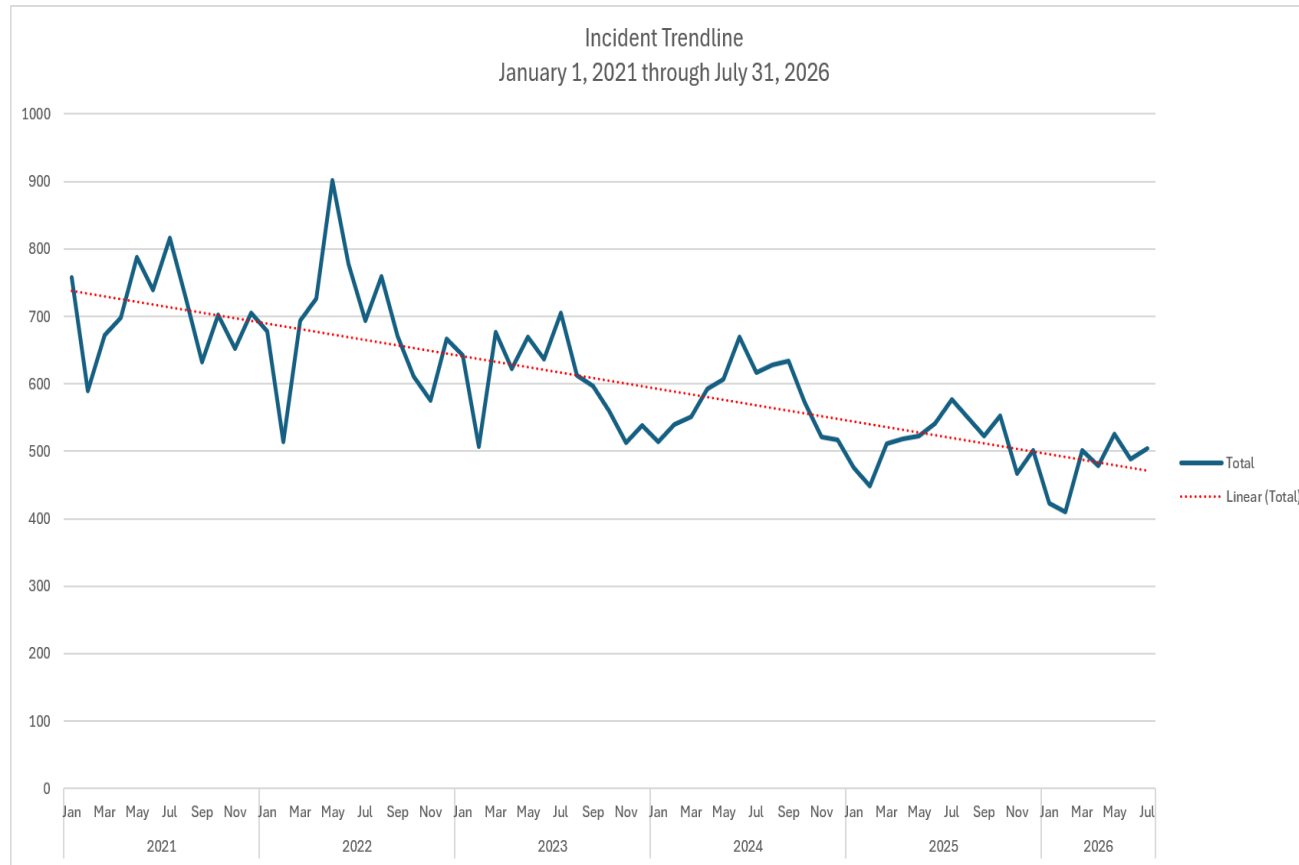


Aggravated Assault

Aggravated assaults are down overall **-3.77%**. **116 Fewer Victims.**

Agg assault FV has increased 0.32% **(3)** and NFV is down **-5.55%** **(119)** YTD as of July 31, 2026.

CrimeTrends: *January 1, 2021 – July 31, 2026*



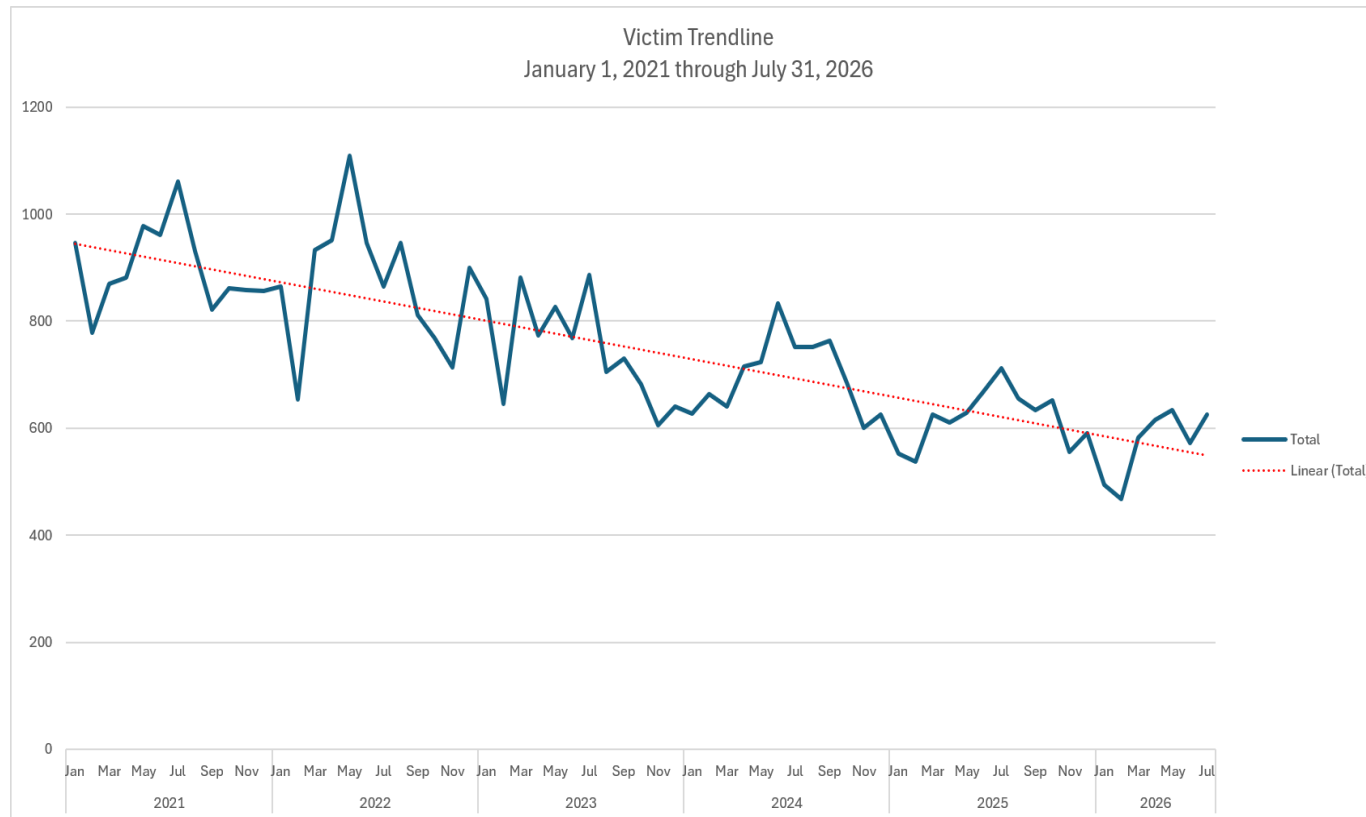
Incident Trendline
