WHEREAS, a lawsuit, styled Louis Brown, Sr. v. City of Dallas, Lyft, Inc. d/b/a Lyft Drives Texas, Inc., and Nicole Jalemah Morrieson, Cause No. DC-23-17846, was filed by the plaintiff, Louis Brown, Sr., seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on October 29, 2021, involving a Code Compliance Department employee operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff, Louis Brown, Sr., has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claims whereby the City will pay Louis Brown, Sr., The Galvan Law Firm, PLLC, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the lawsuit filed by Louis Brown, Sr. styled, Louis Brown, Sr. v. City of Dallas, Lyft, Inc. d/b/a Lyft Drives Texas, Inc., and Nicole Jalemah Morrieson, Cause No. DC-23-17846, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Louis Brown, Sr., The Galvan Law Firm, PLLC, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$75,000.00 from the Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
