**WHEREAS**, November 2017, a Capital Bond Program was approved by voters; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the City of Dallas' desire to substantially complete the Bond funded projects within a five-year period; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 Bond Program includes \$500,000.00 for the Oak Lawn/Cedar Springs Area Sidewalk Improvements (PB17V156). However, it was recommended by Council District 2 to reprogram the project for alley improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to reconstruct the alley between Knight Street and Douglas Avenue from Rosewood Avenue to Sylvester Street, and to reconstruct the alley between Cherrywood Avenue and Inwood Road from Vandelia Street to Rawlins Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$500,000.00 of funding for the 2017 Bond Program's, Oak Lawn/Cedar Springs Area Sidewalk Improvements Project, could potentially serve as a funding source; and

**WHEREAS**, as requested by Council District 2, Public Works prepared cost estimates of \$159,500.00 to reconstruct the alley between Knight Street and Douglas Avenue, and \$291,000.00 to reconstruct the alley between Cherrywood Avenue and Inwood Road.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to reprogram 2017 Bond Funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 from the Oak Lawn/Cedar Springs Area Sidewalk Improvements (PB17V156) to reconstruct the alley between Knight Street and Douglas Avenue from Rosewood Avenue to Sylvester Street, and to reconstruct the alley between Cherrywood Avenue and Inwood Road from Vandelia Street to Rawlins Street.

**SECTION 2.** That the original project, which is the Oak Lawn/Cedar Springs Area Sidewalk Improvements Project will be cancelled, and it is now recommended to replace the 2017 Bond Funds with Certificate of Obligations Fund.

**SECTION 3.** That this item has no cost consideration to the City. While this item, which is the reprogramming of funds, does not have a cost consideration, the projected cost of this reprogramming is \$500,000.00.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
