**WHEREAS**, on September 11, 2024, the City Council authorized a construction services contract with Camino Construction, LP for the installation of water and wastewater mains at twenty-one locations, in an amount not to exceed \$11,631,673.00, by Resolution No. 24-1305; and

**WHEREAS**, prior to the beginning of construction at one of the locations, Reverchon Drive from Overcrest Street to Avon Street, it was determined that storm drainage improvements were needed in addition to the proposed water and wastewater main improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, storm drainage improvements have been designed and need to be installed to limit disruption to the public for multiple improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Camino Construction, LP, 1208 Metro Park, Lewisville, Texas 75057, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dallas Water Utilities Department recommends that Contract No. DWU-2024-00023513 be increased by \$1,254,100.00, from \$11,631,673.00 to \$12,885,733.00.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That an increase in the construction services contract with Camino Construction, LP, (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for storm drainage system improvements in Reverchon Drive from Mateur Street to Avon Street, in an amount not to exceed \$1,254,100.00, increasing the original contract amount from \$11,631,673.00 to \$12,885,733.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the proposed Change Order No. 1 with Camino Construction, LP, be accepted, and that Contract No. DWU-2024-00023513 be revised accordingly.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,254,100.00 to Camino Construction, LP from the Storm Drainage Management Capital Construction Fund, Fund 0063, Department SDM, Unit W742, Object 4599, Program SD23W742, Encumbrance/Contract No. DWU-2024-00023513, Vendor 144735.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
