WHEREAS, on November 9, 2022, the City Council authorized the ratification of a resolution for the construction services contract for an emergency contract to repair the pavement and its supporting sloped embankment of the 1300 block of North Cockrell Hill Road, in an amount not to exceed \$1,211,088.00, by Resolution No. 22-1674; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2023, Administrative Action No. 23-0749 authorized Change Order No. 1 to the construction services contract with Camino Construction, L.P. to excavate two test pits on the slopes next to the pavement, in an amount not to exceed \$14,000.00, increasing the contract amount from \$1,211,088.00 to \$1,225,088.00; and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize Change Order No. 2 to the construction services contract with Camino Construction, L.P. to add funding for the extra work to stabilize the slope next to the pavement at the 1300 block of North Cockrell Hill Road from Davis Street to Pinnacle Point Drive, in an amount not to exceed \$576,128.50, increasing the contract amount from \$1,225,088.00 to \$1,801,216.50.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the emergency construction services contract with Camino Construction, L.P. (Change Order No. 2) is authorized to add funding for the extra work to stabilize the slope next to the pavement at the 1300 block of North Cockrell Hill Road from Davis Street to Pinnacle Point Drive, in an amount not to exceed \$576,128.50, increasing the contract amount from \$1,225,088.00 to \$1,801,216.50.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$576,128.50 (subject to annual appropriations) to Camino Construction, L.P. from the Street and Alley Improvement Fund, Fund 0715, Department PBW, Unit W222, Activity PB51, Object 3210, Program PBCUR050, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-PBW-2022-00020125, Vendor 144735.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
