WHEREAS, on August 18, 2021, the City Council was briefed on allocation of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act, including allocation of \$2,250,000 for Nonprofits Assistance to provide small grants to nonprofit organizations to mitigate negative financial impacts from the pandemic.; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2021, the City Council authorized the final reading and adoption of the appropriation ordinance for the FY 2021-22 City of Dallas Operating, Capital, and Grant & Trust Budgets, which included the American Rescue Plan Act funds from the U.S. Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds by Resolution No. 21-1590; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will benefit from a city-wide nonprofit grant program for residents of Dallas that have been impacted and/or had their needs exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. a nonprofit grant program to assist community-based non-profit organizations by providing funding through a grant process for operational expenses.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a subrecipient contract with United Way of Metropolitan Dallas (VC20595), with a one year renewal option approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a non-profit grant program to assist community-based non-profit organizations ~~by providing funding for operational expenses~~ for the Office of Community Care for a term of one year in an amount of \$1,742,000, with a one-year renewal option in the amount of \$858,000, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,600,000. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to United Way of Metropolitan Dallas shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by United Way of Metropolitan Dallas under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,600,000 (subject to annual appropriations) from Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, Fund FC18, Department MGT, Unit AD20 Object 3070 to United Way of Metropolitan Dallas from Subrecipient Contract No. OCC22-00019179.

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SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
