City Council Briefing



I-635 LBJ East

- \$1.7 billion
- Reconstruction of I-635 from US 75 to I-30.
- Includes reconstruction of the I-635/I-30 interchange.
- Includes the Skillman Avenue tied arch bridge.
- Spring 2026 completion.





SM Wright Freeway

- \$78 million
- Reconstruction of US 175 to a 6-lane urban arterial
- Wrapping up final traffic signals, sidewalk, and landscaping.
- SM Wright Freeway will become the City of Dallas' roadway once complete.





US 175 at Lake June



- Reconstructing the Lake June overpass across US 175.
- Pedestrian connection parallel to US 175 that ties to the Loop.
- \$26 million.
- Spring 2026 completion.



I-20 Frontage Roads at Red Bird


- \$79 million
- New frontage roads along I-20 to provide better access from Cockrell Hill Road to Hampton Road.
- Complete June 2025.





I-345 Bridge Maintenance

- \$21 million
- Re-decking several locations.
- Superstructure repairs.
- Skid application on bridge deck to help during wet weather.
- Complete October 2025.

Hybrid Option identified as Recommended Alternative


Recommended Alternative to be carried into the I-345 Connects Project Schematic & Environmental Phase

I-345 Project Funding

- TxDOT's 2026 Unified Transportation Program (UTP)
 - \$75 million Category 2
 - \$45 million Category 4
 - \$250 million Category 12 Commission Strategic Priority
 - Total = \$370 million
- Will continue to request funds as TxDOT updates the UTP annually.
- Potential Category 6 (Bridge Replacement funds) = \$225 million
- Submitted for Federal Highway Bridge Grant
- Potential value of surplus ROW to be used towards construction
