WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, City Council authorized a construction contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC for the replacement of water and wastewater mains at 26 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$11,941,371.00, by Resolution No. 20-1023; and

WHEREAS, additional pavement restoration associated with the installation of water and wastewater mains is required beyond the amount originally quantified for the project; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, 2005 Bluff Springs Road, Ferris, Texas 75125, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 19-263/264 be increased by \$1,962,835.00 from \$11,941,371.00 to \$13,904,206.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for additional pavement restoration associated with the installation of water and wastewater mains at 26 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$1,962,835.00, increasing the contact amount from \$11,941,371.00 to \$13,904,206.00.

SECTION 2. That the proposed Change Order No. 1 with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, be accepted, and that Contract No. 19-263/264 be revised accordingly.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,962,835.00 to Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, as follows:
