~~**WHEREAS**, the City, through its Park & Recreation Department, hereby desires to authorize a one-year concessions agreement with Legends Hospitality LLC to provide food and beverage operations at Fair Park, including the Cotton Bowl.~~

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

~~**SECTION 1.** That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a one-year concessions agreement, with a one-year renewal option with Legends Hospitality LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide food and beverage operations at Fair Park, including the Cotton Bowl, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00, with an estimated annual net revenue amount of \$1,000,000.00.~~

~~**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 to Legends Hospitality LLC from Fair Park Fund, Fund 0A09, Department PKR, Unit 6502, Object 3072, Encumbrance/Contract No. PKR-2026-00029486, Vendor VC0000073094.~~

~~**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit revenue funds from Legends Hospitality LLC in Fair Park Fund, Fund 0A09, Department PKR, Unit 6502, Revenue Code 7264.~~

~~**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.~~
