WHEREAS, on December 8, 2021, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for analytical laboratory testing services for the Water Utilities Department with Eurofins-Xenco, LLC in the estimated amount of \$6,710,072.00, by Resolution No. 21-1987; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to reject the bids that were received for Group 2; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a service price agreement with Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc., lowest responsible bidders of six for Groups 1, 3, and 4.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That all bids received for solicitation BW24-00026115 for Group 2 for analytical laboratory testing services are hereby rejected.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. (VC0000034435) for Group 1 in the estimated amount of \$6,153,236.00 and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc. (VC0000034462) for Groups 3 and 4 in the estimated amount of \$59,840.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for analytical laboratory testing services for the Dallas Water Utilities Department for a term of three years, in the total estimated amount of \$6,213,076.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc., shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Southern Petroleum Laboratories Inc. and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc., under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$6,213,076.00 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2024-00026115.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
