WHEREAS, on January 11, 2023, the City Council authorized the application for and acceptance of the 2022 FY22 Supporting Law Enforcement Agencies in Seeking Accreditation Grant in the amount of \$250,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice passed through the Dallas Police Department for the period of September 1, 2022, through August 31, 2024, by Resolution No. 23-0130; and

WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas under the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), 2025 FY25 Community Policing Development: Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant, Grant No. 15JCOPS-25-GG-00696-PPSE, Assistance Listing No. 16.710 for the Fiscal Years (FY) 2026 and 2027; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) for the 2025 FY25 Community Policing Development (CPD): Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant (Federal Award ID. No. 15JCOPS-25-GG-00696-PPSE, Assistance Listing No. 16.710) in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the purpose of funding one administrative specialist position and one supervisor position dedicated to proving compliance with 173 Texas law enforcement best practices for two years for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2027; and execution of the grant agreement with COPS and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 in the COPS FY25 CPD Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant Fund, Fund F808, Department DPD, Unit 684K, Object 1101.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 in the COPS FY25 CPD Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant Fund, Fund F808, Department DPD, Unit 684K, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 from the COPS FY25 CPD Supporting Agencies Seeking Accreditation Grant Fund, Fund F808, Department DPD, Unit 684K, Object 1101.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the Department of Justice in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the Department of Justice final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00029229.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
