**WHEREAS**, on January 13, 2021, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for the maintenance, repair, line striping, and surface coating of multi-sport court surfaces for the Park & Recreation Department with Hellas Construction, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$916,369.84, by Resolution No. 21-0144.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Hellas Construction, Inc. (VS0000078437) in the estimated amount of \$710,168.00 and GG Contractors, LLC. (VC16816) in the estimated amount of \$382,500.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the restoration maintenance, repair, lining, striping, and surface coating of multi-sport court surfaces for the Park & Recreation Department for a term of three years, in the total estimated amount of \$1,092,668.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Hellas Construction, Inc., and to GG Contractors, LLC. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Hellas Construction, Inc., and GG Contractors, LLC. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated total amount of at least \$1,092,668.00 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Hellas Construction, Inc., and to GG Contractors, LLC. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. PKR-2024-00024452.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
