WHEREAS, on April 13, 2022, the City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for the purchase of neighborhood air quality sensor equipment for the Office of Environmental Quality and Sustainability with Ambilabs, LLC in the estimated amount of \$192,662.40 and Wilbur Technical Services, LLC in the estimated amount of \$37,350.00, for a total estimated amount of \$230,012.40, by Resolution No. 22-0568.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to extend the master agreement with Ambilabs, LLC (VC24746), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the continued purchase of neighborhood air quality sensor equipment to extend the term from October 13, 2025 to April 13, 2026 and to modify the funding source from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to the ARPA Redevelopment Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$67,000.00, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term from the ARPA Redevelopment Fund, Fund 0A72, Department MGT, Unit AR40, Object 3099 to Ambilabs, LLC and Wilbur Technical Services, LLC from Master Agreement Contract No. OEQ-2022-00017994.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
