\$1.5M+ Annual Investment

- \$770,000 – Facilities investment
 - Structural maintenance, infrastructure repairs, etc.
- Capital improvements: \$200k+
- \$400,000 – Utilities

 - Bond Projects
 - Master Plan
 - Garden Renovations
