WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, the City Council authorized the adoption of the Comprehensive Environmental & Climate Action Plan to reduce City of Dallas greenhouse gas emissions by 43% below 2015 levels by 230 by Council Resolution No. 20-0827; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Energy's State and Community Energy Programs provides grant assistance to communities to promote energy conservation and increase sustainability; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Energy to benefit from the additional funds to improve energy efficiency at City facilities.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (Grant Award No. DE-SE0000953, CFDA No. 81.128) in the amount of \$1,132,070.00 to upgrade five City facilities to energy efficient light emitting diode lighting for the period October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2026; and execution of the grant agreement with the DOE and all terms, conditions and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,132,070.00 in the DOE EECBG Program BIL 2021 Grant Fund, Fund F779, Department FRM, Unit 681G, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$1,132,070.00 in the DOE EECBG Program BIL 2021 Grant Fund, Fund F779, Department FRM, Unit 681G, Object 3099.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,132,070.00 in the DOE EECBG Program BIL 2021 Grant Fund, Fund F779, Department FRM, Unit 681G, Object 3099, Activity EB01.

SECTION 5. That this grant agreement is designated as Contract No. FRM-2025-00026306.

SECTION 7. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
