WHEREAS, a lawsuit styled Yohannes Seyoum v. City of Dallas, Cause No. CC-22-04522-D was filed by the plaintiff, Yohannes Seyoum, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages he sustained in an automobile collision on March 17, 2021, with a Dallas Police Department employee who was operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claim whereby the City will pay Yohannes Seyoum, John R. Salazar, P.C., and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. The proposed settlement of the lawsuit styled <u>Yohannes Seyoum v. City of Dallas, Cause No. CC-22-04522-D</u>, in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Yohannes Seyoum, John R. Salazar, P.C., and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$80,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
