**WHEREAS**, the State Fair of Texas (SFT) has been a part of the City of Dallas for over 135 years providing the fair experience, which has grown into a tradition drawing over two million visitors to Fair Park every Fall; and

**WHEREAS**, with such a of number of visitors comes the need to provide the emergency medical services, which STF has been providing through private services for the non-emergency medical transport; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dallas through its Dallas Fire-Rescue Department annually provide over thirty emergency medical transport responses dispatched through the 9-1-1 call; and

**WHEREAS**, the SFT request the City to consider developing an agreement for the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department to provide the emergency services during the fair for the next three years from 2023 to 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dallas Fire-Rescue Department intend to utilize the special event rescues which will alleviate the need to dispatch a front-line rescue and hence making it available for use on other medical related calls.

**NOW, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a three-year service agreement with State Fair of Texas (SFT), for the City of Dallas through Dallas Fire-Rescue Department to provide the emergency services in the estimated amount of \$590,025.00 during **(1)** the fair at Fair Park every Fall in 2023 to 2025 on the specified dates; and **(2)** July Events and additional Special Events to be charged separately per the agreed rates, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds from the State Fair of Texas in the estimated amount of \$187,200.00 (Year 1), \$196,500.00 (Year 2), and \$206,325.00 (Year 3) for an estimated total amount of \$590,025.00 for the fair and additional funds for the July and Special Events charged as per the agreed rates in General Fund, Fund 0001, Department DFD, Unit ER90, Revenue Code 7654, from Service Agreement Contract No. DFD-2023-00022122.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
