WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Juvenile and Delinquency Prevention has made continuation grant funds available to aid missing and exploited children during Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26; and

WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas for the 2025-2026 Internet Crimes Against Children Grant, Grant No. 15PJDP-25-GK-01588-MECP for the allocation of FY 2025-26; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Justice Programs, for the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) FY25 Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program Grant (Grant No. 15PJDP-25-GK-01588-MECP, Assistance Listing No. 16.543) in the amount of \$848,825.00 for response to the sexual abuse and exploitation of children facilitated by the use of computer technology related to the investigation of the internet-facilitated child exploitation for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; and execute the grant agreement with the DOJ and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations an amount not to exceed \$848,825.00, in the OJJDP FY25 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Grant Fund, Fund F815, Department DPD, Unit 684Y, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds an amount not to exceed \$848,825.00 in the OJJDP FY25 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Grant Fund, Fund F815, Department DPD, Unit 684Y, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds an amount not to exceed \$848,825.00 from the OJJDP FY25 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Grant Fund, Fund F815, Department DPD, Unit 684Y, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the DOJ, Office of Justice Programs in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the DOJ, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Division, final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00029643.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
