An ordinance correcting Section 51A-7.205, "Athletic Field Signs, Special Purpose Signs, Movement Control Signs, and Protective Signs," of Chapter 51A, "Dallas Development Code: Ordinance No. 19455, as amended," of the Dallas City Code; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the city council finds that it is in the public interest to correct Chapter 51A to accurately reflect the intent of the city council; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Subsection (c) of Section 51A-7.205, "Athletic Field Signs, Portable Signs, Special Purpose Signs, Movement Control Signs, and Protective Signs," of Division 51A-7.200, "Provisions For All Zoning Districts," of Article VII, "Sign Regulations," of Chapter 51A, "Dallas Development Code: Ordinance No. 19455, as amended," of the Dallas City Code is amended to read as follows:

- "(c) <u>Special purpose signs</u>. Special purpose signs, whether attached or detached, are prohibited in all business and non-business zoning districts unless expressly authorized in a special provision sign district or a planned development district [Reserved]."
- SECTION 2. That Chapter 51A of the Dallas City Code shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That any act done or right vested or accrued, or any proceeding, suit, or prosecution had or commenced in any action before the amendment or repeal of any ordinance, or part thereof, shall not be affected or impaired by amendment or repeal of any ordinance, or part thereof, and shall be treated as still remaining in full force and effect for all intents and purposes as if the amended or repealed ordinance, or part thereof, had remained in force.

SECTION 4. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.
