WHEREAS, on December 8, 2021, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for analytical laboratory testing services for the Water Utilities Department with Eurofins-Xenco, LLC in the estimated amount of \$6,710,072.00, by Resolution No. 21-1987; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2025, the City Council authorized (1) the rejection of bids received for Group 2 for analytical laboratory testing services; and (2) a three-year service price agreement for Groups 1, 3, and 4 for analytical laboratory testing services for the Dallas Water Utilities Department with Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$6,153,236.00 and North Water District Laboratory Services, Inc. in the estimated of \$59,840.00, by Resolution No. 25-1362.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to **(1)** terminate the three-year service price agreement with Southern Petroleum Laboratories, Inc. dba SPL, Inc. for Group 1 for analytical laboratory testing services previously approved on August 27, 2025, by Resolution No. 25-1362; and **(2)** execute a service price agreement for Group 1 for analytical laboratory testing services for the Dallas Water Utilities Department with Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC dba Eurofins Xenco (VC32008) approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of three years in the estimated amount of \$6,235,891.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC, dba Eurofins Xenco shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC dba Eurofins Xenco under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$6,235,891.00 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC dba Eurofins Xenco from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2024-00026115.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
