WHEREAS, the City Charter provides for the Park and Recreation Board to approve agreements or contracts within the department for the acceptance of grants as it shall deem proper; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas, Park & Recreation Department (City) and the National Recreation and Park Association desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of accepting the Mentoring Program grant in the amount of \$60,000.00, for the purpose of implementing the Out-of-School Time Youth Mentoring Program; and

WHEREAS, the City will purchase materials, supplies, and provide the in-kind staffing to support the program; and target specific target audiences to participate in the program.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention through the National Recreation and Park Association, Inc. (NRPA) for the 2024 Out-of-School Time (OST) Youth Mentoring Program (Award No. 15PJDP-24-GG-03819-MENT, Assistance Listing No. 16.726) in the amount of \$60,000.00 for the implementation of the program titled L.E.A.D. (Learn, Empower, Achieve, Develop) for the period May 22, 2025 through September 30, 2027; and execution of the grant agreement with NRPA and all terms, conditions and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the program implementation will be performed by City staff.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 in the NRPA FY24 OST Youth Mentoring Program Grant Fund, Fund F795, Department PKR, Unit 683D, Object 3070.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 to the NRPA FY24 OST Youth Mentoring Program Grant Fund, Fund F795, Department PKR, Unit 683D, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 from the NRPA FY24 OST Youth Mentoring Program Grant Fund, Fund F795, Department PKR, Unit 683D, Object 3070.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse the granting agency any expenditure identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

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SECTION 7. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 8. That this contract is designated as Contract No. PKR-2025-00027928.

SECTION 9. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provision of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
