Final Draft Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Chapter 49, “Water and Wastewater,” of the Dallas City Code by amending Section 49-43, amending the uniform concentration limits for wastewater discharged at certain treatment plants; providing a penalty not to exceed \$2,000; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Paragraph (3), “Uniform Concentration Limits For Wastewater Discharged to the Trinity River Authority Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant,” of Subsection (c), “Local Limits,” of Section 49-43, “Certain Wastes Prohibited in the Wastewater System,” of Article IV, “Water Quality,” of Chapter 49, “Water and Wastewater,” of the Dallas City Code is amended to read as follows:

“(3) Uniform concentration limits for wastewater discharged to the Trinity River Authority Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.

[In this paragraph, ~~TOTAL TOXIC ORGANICS (TTO)~~ means the sum of the masses or concentration of the toxic organic compounds listed in 40 CFR Part 122, Appendix D, Table II, excluding pesticides, found in the discharges of industrial users at a concentration greater than 0.01 mg/L.]”

SECTION 2. That Subsection (c), “Local Limits,” of Section 49-43, “Certain Wastes Prohibited in Wastewater System,” of Article IV, “Water Quality,” of Chapter 49, “Water and Wastewater,” of the Dallas City Code is amended by adding a new Paragraph (4), “Uniform Concentration Limits for Wastewater Discharged to the City for Garland Wastewater Treatment Plant,” to read as follows:

“(4) Uniform concentration limits for wastewater discharged to the City of Garland Wastewater Treatment Plant.

SECTION 3. That a person violating a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.

SECTION 4. That Chapter 49 of the Dallas City Code shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That any act done or right vested or accrued, or any proceeding, suit, or prosecution had or commenced in any action before the amendment or repeal of any ordinance, or part thereof, shall not be affected or impaired by amendment or repeal of any ordinance, or part thereof, and shall be treated as still remaining in full force and effect for all intents and purposes as if the amended or repealed ordinance, or part thereof, had remained in force.

SECTION 6. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.
