**WHEREAS,** the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires that all waste disposed of at a landfill be covered at the end of each operating day to control odors, litter, pests, and fire hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the McCommas Bluff Landfill permit allows for the use of soil, synthetic tarps, and cellulose-based spray-on materials as acceptable forms of daily cover; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of spray-on alternative daily cover is the most time-efficient and operationally effective method, preserving landfill airspace and extending the life of the landfill compared to traditional soil cover methods.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase a high-capacity alternate daily cover spray application unit for the Department of Sanitation Services with LSC Environmental Products, LLC (VC21104), approved as to form by the City Attorney, in an amount not to exceed \$182,334.14. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to LSC Environmental Products, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by LSC Environmental Products, LLC under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in a not to exceed amount of \$182,334.14 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the number of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to LSC Environmental Products, LLC from Master Agreement Contract No. SAN-2025-00027346.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
