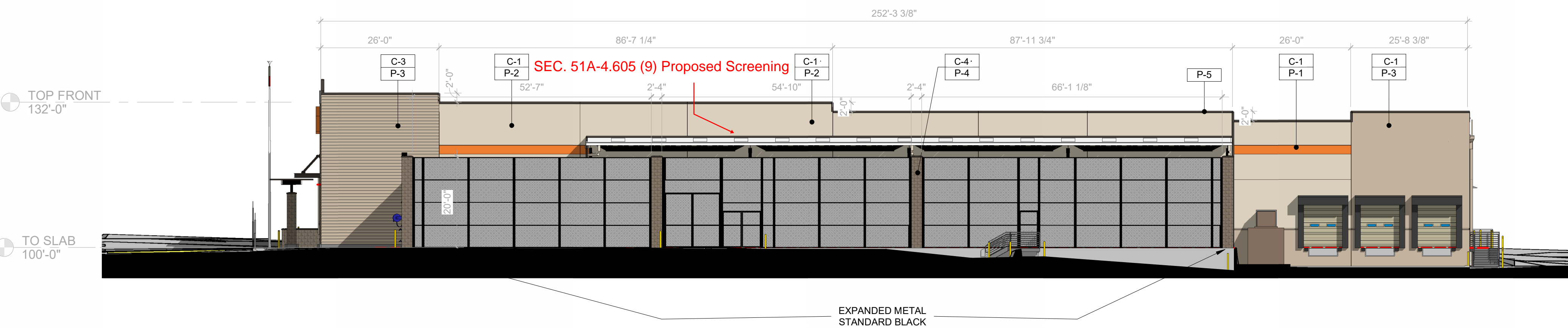
Front Elevation

Left Elevation

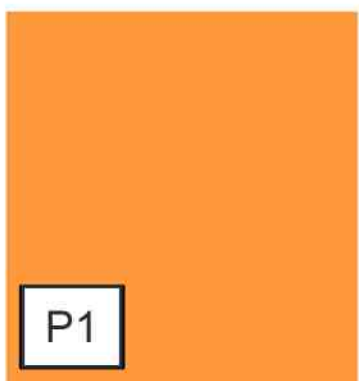

Miscellaneous Design Standards Outdoor display, sales, and storage areas, such as nursery departments, must be enclosed by screening with a solid base with a minimum height of three feet surmounted by a wrought iron or tubular steel fence with a minimum height of five feet. The screening must be surmounted with a minimum of two feet of fascia with materials and colors matching the main building. No merchandise other than trees may be visible above the screening.
