**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Article X of the Dallas City Code establishes a Public Art Program to include works of art and design services of artists in certain City capital improvement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, in carrying out the intent of the Public Art Program, the Office of Arts and Culture, working with the Public Art Committee, has identified a public art project to be installed at the Crockett Dog Park located at 501 N Carroll Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75246; and

**WHEREAS**, Su Jin Lim DBA Cloud Study LLC, a sole proprietor, was chosen by selection panel for the project and was recommended by the Public Art Committee and the Arts and Culture Advisory Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, \$200,000.00 is now currently available from the 2006 and the 2017 Park and Recreation Bond Funds to support the development, fabrication and installation of a site-specific artwork at Crockett Dog Park located at 501 North Carroll Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75246.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Su Jin Lim DBA Cloud Study LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to develop, fabricate and install a site-specific artwork at the Crockett Dog Park located at 501 North Carroll Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75246, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00. The services shall be considered fully complete and accepted only upon the formal approval of the Director of the Office of Arts and Culture.

**SECTION 2.** That in order to reimburse and finance the authorized disbursements described herein from General Obligation Bonds, the City intends to issue one or more commercial paper notes as part of its General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series 2017A, and Series 2017B, and use the proceeds thereof to reimburse the disbursements described herein.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 to Su Jin Lim DBA Cloud Study LLC from Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Fund, Fund 1V00, Department PKR, Unit PA56, Object 4425, Program PK17PA56, Encumbrance/Contract No. MASC-OCA-2024-00025977, Vendor VC31194.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution does not constitute a binding agreement upon the City or subject the City to any liability or obligation with respect to this transaction until such as time as the documents are duly approved by all parties and executed.
