WHEREAS, on February 18, 2022, four bids were received for the installation and rehabilitation of water and wastewater mains and appurtenances at 13 locations, Contract No. 21-341/342, listed as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, 2005 Bluff Springs Road, Ferris, Texas 75125, in the amount of \$13,921,735.00, is the lowest and best of all bids received.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the bid submitted by Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$13,921,735.00 for doing the work covered by the plans, specifications, and contract documents, Contract No. 21-341/342, be accepted.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction services contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the installation and rehabilitation of water and wastewater mains and appurtenances at 13 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$13,921,735.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$13,921,735.00 to Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, as follows:
