WHEREAS, the Dallas Police Department (“DPD”) Victim Services/23 Grant from the U.S. Department of Treasury pass-through the Texas Office of the Governor (“Office of the Governor”) - Criminal Justice Division (CJD), has made funds available for law enforcement projects during the 2025-26 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas was awarded the Dallas Police Department Victim Services/23 Grant; and

WHEREAS, the increased program and funding source would benefit the City of Dallas in its endeavor to reduce crime and improve public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Dallas that the Dallas Police Department Victim Services be operated for the 2025-26 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas agrees to provide local cash match funds for the said project as a requirement by the Office of the Governor, CJD grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds, the City of Dallas assures that the funds identified as ineligible will be returned to the CJD; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas designates the City Manager or designee as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division (CJD) for the FY 2026 Victims of Crime Supplement (VOCS) Victim Services Grant (Grant No. 1578123, State Award ID No. 2026-VT-STATE FUNDS) in the amount of \$95,415.17 to adequately respond to victims of violent crime with needed aid for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; and execute the grant agreement with the CJD and all terms, conditions and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

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SECTION 2. That the City of Dallas designates the City Manager or designee as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$95,415.17 in the CJD FY26 VOCS Victim Services Grant Fund, Fund S447, Department DPD, Unit 684J, various Object Codes, in accordance with Schedule A.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$95,415.17 in the CJD FY26 VOCS Victim Services Grant Fund, Fund S447, Department DPD, Unit 684J, Revenue Code 6516.

SECTION 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$95,415.17 from the CJD FY26 VOCS Victim Services Grant Fund, Fund S447, Department DPD, Unit 684J, various Object Codes, in accordance with Schedule A.

SECTION 6. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to provide a local cash match in the amount of \$23,853.79 (subject to appropriations) from General Fund, Fund 0001, Department DPD, Unit 2162, various Object Codes, in accordance with Schedule A.

SECTION 7. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the City of Dallas will return all grant funds to the CJD, in full.

SECTION 8. That the City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of any return of funds not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 9. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 10. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00029232.

SECTION 11. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
