**WHEREAS,** on March 27, 2019, City Council authorized a twenty-four-month contract for the 2019 Sidewalk and Barrier Free Ramp Improvements Program that includes water and wastewater adjustments in Service Maintenance Areas 1 and 2, in an amount not to exceed \$2,432,725.00, by Resolution No. 19-0407; and

WHEREAS, it is now recommended to authorize Change Order No. 1 to extend the construction services contract an additional twelve months from the original twenty-four month contract, from the original contract period of April 15, 2019 to April 15, 2021, to the extended contract period to April 15, 2022 with Estrada Concrete Company, LLC due to the contractor's outstanding performance and the agreement to continue using the original contract bid rates, in an amount not to exceed \$608,181.25, increasing the contract amount from \$2,432,725.00 to \$3,040,906.25.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That an increase in the construction services contract with Estrada Concrete Company, LLC (Change Order No.1) is authorized for the sidewalk and barrier free ramp installation paving services, to extend that contract for an additional twelve months from the original twenty-four month contract, from the original contract period of April 15, 2019 to April 15, 2021, to the extended contract period to April 15, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$608,181.25, increasing the contract amount from \$2,432,725.00 to \$3,040,906.25, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$608,181.25 to Estrada Concrete Company, LLC, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from Street and Transportation (A) Fund, Fund 2U22, Department PBW, Unit W646, Activity SIDI, Object 4530, Program PBSI0003, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX- PBW-2019-00008826, Vendor 511236.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
