~~**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Dallas College (VS0000065958) in the amount of \$250,000 and Dallas County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center dba Metrocare Services (VS0000048211) in the amount of \$250,000, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for workforce training for the Small Business Center for a term of two years, in the total amount not to exceed \$500,000. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Dallas College and Dallas County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center dba Metrocare Services shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Dallas College and Dallas County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center dba Metrocare Services under the contract.~~

~~**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 (subject to annual appropriation) from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, Fund FC18, Department MGT, Unit AD31, Object 3099 to Dallas College and Dallas County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center dba Metrocare Services from Service Contract No. SBC-2022-00019143.~~

~~**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.~~
