WHEREAS, on May 16, 2023, City Council authorized a construction services contract with Omega Contracting, LLC for the construction of (1) a twelve-month master agreement for water and wastewater small services installations; (2) the installation of water and wastewater mains at four locations; and (3) and a twelve-month master agreement for water and wastewater mainline extensions and emergency mainline installations and relocations at various locations, in an amount not to exceed \$13,694,429.80, by Resolution No. 23-0579; and

WHEREAS, additional work is required for the installation of permitted wastewater services due to a significantly higher than anticipated volume of permitted wastewater service line requests and the need to extend the contract duration by 6 months; and

WHEREAS, Omega Contracting, LLC, 2518 Chalk Hill Road, Dallas, Texas 75211, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 22-497/498 be increased by \$2,738,807.25, from \$13,694,429.80 to \$16,433,237.05.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Omega Contracting, LLC (Change Order No.1) is authorized for additional work associated with the installation of permitted wastewater services, in an amount not to exceed \$2,738,807.25, increasing the contract amount from \$13,694,429.80 to \$16,433,237.05.

SECTION 2. That the proposed Change Order No.1 with Omega Contracting, LLC be accepted, and that Contract No. 22-497/498 be revised accordingly.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,738,807.25 to Omega Contracting, LLC from Wastewater Construction Fund, Fund 0103, Department DWU, Unit CS40, Object 4560, Program 722498, Vendor 345379, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-DWU-2023-00021613.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
