WHEREAS, on July 15, 2020, a Request for Qualifications was issued for Engineering, Architecture and Landscape Architecture Consulting Services for 2020 Capital Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Administrative Directive 4-05, Metropolitan Infrastructure, PLLC was selected as the most qualified consultant for design and surveying services at Lakewood Park; and

WHEREAS, it is now desirable to authorize a professional services contract with Metropolitan Infrastructure, PLLC for design and surveying services for a steel pedestrian bridge across White Rock Creek Branch with concrete trail and sidewalk connections at Lakewood Park located at 7143 Williamson Road, in an amount not to exceed \$78,575.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a professional services contract with Metropolitan Infrastructure, PLLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for design and surveying services for the design of a steel pedestrian bridge across Williamson Branch with walking trail connections at Lakewood Park located at 7143 Williamson Road, in an amount not to exceed \$78,575.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$78,575.00 to Metropolitan Infrastructure, PLLC from Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Fund, Fund 1V00, Department PKR, Unit VK24, Object 4111, Activity RFSI, Program PK17VK24, Encumbrance/Contract No. PKR-2021-00016444, Commodity 92500, Vendor 512079.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
