**WHEREAS**, on April 13, 2016, the City Council authorized a three-year master agreement for hand and power tools with Sid Tool Co., Inc. dba MSC Industrial Supply Co. in the amount of \$2,720,901.20, Colonial Hardware Corporation in the amount of \$1,655,229.88, Simba Industries in the amount of \$1,440,288.00, Mavich LLC in the amount of \$367,567.25, Nationwide Supplies, LP in the amount of \$270,430.39, Longhorn, Inc. in the amount of \$121,400.00, Hilti, Inc. in the amount of \$60,715.02, Fort Worth Bolt & Tool Company in the amount of \$52,960.00, Evco Partners LP dba Burgoon Company in the amount of \$32,500.00, Joe Jeter Sales in the amount of \$20,000.00, and Fastenal Company in the amount of \$14,500.00, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,756,941.74, by Resolution No. 16-0526; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 11, 2019, the City Council authorized three-year master agreement for hand and power and tools with Sid Tool Co., Inc. dba MSC Industrial Supply Co. in the estimated amount of \$2,664,544.00, Crawford Electric Supply Co. dba Trinity Electric Supply Co. in an estimated amount of \$1,170,899.00, Simba Industries in an estimated amount of \$1,021,152.00, Nationwide Supplies in an estimated amount of \$1,014,504.00, Colonial Hardware Corporation in an estimated amount of \$236,800.00, Snap-On Tools in an estimated amount of \$213,250.00, Lone Star Mower in an estimated amount of \$126,110.00, Hilti, Inc. in an estimated amount of \$82,525.00, MHC Kenworth South Dallas in an estimated amount of \$28,150.00, and Mavich, LLC in an estimated amount of \$27,130.00, in a total estimated amount of \$6,585,064.00, by Resolution No. 19-1919.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That a master agreement for the purchase of hand and power tool supplies to be used citywide is authorized with Sid Tool Co., Inc. dba MSC Industrial Supply Co. (150516) in an estimated amount of \$5,520,015.33, Nationwide Supplies dba USA Supply (VS0000002561) in an estimated amount of \$3,589,480.68, Colonial Hardware Corporation (501147) in an estimated amount of \$2,006,625.73, Elliot Electric Supply (517114) in an estimated amount of \$663,155.10, Ewing Irrigation Products, Inc. (VS0000016819) in an estimated amount of \$409,500.00, Snap-On Tools dba Snap-On Industrial (037769) in an estimated amount of \$317,300.00, and Hilti Inc. (079626) in an estimated amount of \$156,800.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for a term of three years, in a total estimated amount of \$12,662,876.84. The amount payable pursuant to this master agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the contract for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

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**SECTION 2.** That the Purchasing Agent is authorized, upon appropriate request and documented need by a user department, to issue a purchase order for hand and power tool supplies to be used citywide. If a written contract is required or requested for any or all purchases for hand and power tool supplies to be used citywide under the master agreement instead of individual purchase orders, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$12,662,876.84, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master agreement during its term to Sid Tool Co., Inc. dba MSC Industrial Supply Co., Nationwide Supplies dba USA Supply, Colonial Hardware Corporation, Elliott Electric Supply, Ewing Irrigation Products, Inc., Snap-On Tools dba Snap-On Industrial, and Hilti Inc. from Master Agreement Contract No. POM-2022-00020023.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
