WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a professional engineering services contract with Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., for Streetlighting Design along Walton Walker Boulevard from Country Creek Drive to Spur 408; and other related tasks (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2024, the City of Dallas, Department of Transportation (City) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) from the Short-Listed Engineering firms that were selected under the Civil and Transportation Engineering Categories as part of the Dallas Airport System Pre-Qualified Architectural and Engineering Consulting Services, Solicitation Number: CIZ23-AVI-2097, to provide electrical and civil engineering services for streetlighting design along Walton Walker Boulevard from Country Creek Drive to Spur 408 and received one proposal from the following firm:

WHEREAS, Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., was selected by the review committee as the most highly qualified proposer to provide professional services for this Project.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional engineering services contract with Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, for Streetlighting Design along Walton Walker Boulevard from Country Creek Drive to Spur 408; and other related tasks, in an amount not to exceed \$317,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$317,000.00 to Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc., in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from the Equity Fund, Fund 0722, Department TRN, Unit 7303, Object 4111, Program TP730324, Encumbrance/Contract No. TRN-2024-00025417, Vendor 135447.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
