**WHEREAS**, on November 28, 2018, the City Council authorized a two-year consultant contract with KPMG LLP. to develop a staffing study for the Dallas Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, by Resolution No 18-1184; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 27, 2020, the City Council authorized a supplemental agreement No. 1 to the consultant contract with KPMG LLP. to extend the terms of the original agreement and provide technical assistance during implementation of recommendations resulting from the consultants staffing study for the Dallas Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.00, by Resolution No. 20-0846; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 3, 2023 the Deputy City Manager approved a request by Dallas Police Department to use the Special Needs/Justification Consultant Selection Process in accordance with City of Dallas Administrative Directive 4-05, deeming KPMG LLP the most qualified for the proposed contract.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a five-year consultant contract with KPMG, LLP (092122) to provide analysis to support the Dallas Police Department, approved as to form by the City Attorney, in the assessment of the Departments policing operations, district demarcation, and operational facility (Patrol Station) footprint, - in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to KPMG, LLP from Service Contract No. DPD-2023-00021660.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
