WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas for the FY23 COPS Technology and Equipment Program Grant, Grant No. 15JCOPS-23-GG-01668-TECP, Assistance Listing No. 16.710 for FY 2022-24; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY23 COPS Technology and Equipment Program Grant (Federal Award ID. No. 15JCOPS-23-GG-01668-TECP, Assistance Listing No. 16.710) in the amount of \$935,000.00 for the purpose to upgrading and replacing the current Record Management System for more efficient record keeping for the period December 29, 2022 through December 31, 2024; and execute the grant agreement and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the grant agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$935,000.00 in the COPS Technology and Equipment Fund, Fund F757, Department DPD, Unit 678M, Object 4731.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$935,000.00 in COPS Technology and Equipment Fund, Fund F757, Department DPD, Unit 678M, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$935,000.00 from the Technology and Equipment Fund, Fund F757, Department DPD, Unit 678M, Object 4731.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the Department of Justice (DOJ) in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the DOJ final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2024-00023388.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
