WHEREAS, Section 6.0301 of the Texas Property Tax Code provides that an appraisal district in a populous county shall be governed by a board of nine directors composed of both appointed and elected directors. Five of the directors are to be appointed by the taxing units that participate in the district in the manner as previously prescribed by Section 6.03 of the Tax Code (the "levy method"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas is allotted 27 votes to cast for any of the individuals nominated to serve on the Collin Central Appraisal District Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.0301 of the Texas Property Tax Code requires the City of Dallas to report to the Chief Appraiser of the Collin Central Appraisal District how its votes are cast no later than December 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the term of office for the persons elected will be for one year beginning on January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2028.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLIN:

SECTION 1. That the City of Dallas casts its 27 votes for the candidate(s) to serve on the Collin Central Appraisal District Board of Directors, as follows:
