WHEREAS, on October 12, 2022, the City Council authorized a construction services contract with Camino Construction, L.P., for the installation of water and wastewater mains at 32 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$21,319,817.00, by Resolution No. 22-1544; and

WHEREAS, additional services are required to complete miscellaneous work associated with water and wastewater main improvements at 17 locations; and

WHEREAS, Camino Construction, L.P., 1208 Metro Park, Lewisville, Texas 75057, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas Water Utilities Department recommends that Contract No. DWU-2022-00020026 be increased by \$880,000.00, from \$21,319,817.00 to \$22,199,817.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Camino Construction, L.P. (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for additional work associated with water and wastewater main improvements at 17 locations, in an amount not to exceed \$880,000.00, increasing the contract amount from \$21,319,817.00 to \$22,199,817.00.

SECTION 2. That the proposed Change Order No. 1 with Camino Construction, L.P., be accepted, and that Contract No. DWU-2022-00020026 be revised accordingly.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$880,000.00 to Camino Construction, L.P., in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract, as follows:
