WHEREAS, on May 28, 2024, a severe weather event occurred in the city of Dallas, creating significant damage and generating approximately 550,000 cubic yards of storm-related debris; and

WHEREAS, emergency debris monitoring services are required for reimbursement eligibility under the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Public Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted an informal emergency solicitation for debris monitoring services, and Tetra Tech, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to **(1)** ratify the purchase and payment of \$225,000.00 incurred for emergency debris monitoring services; and **(2)** a one-year emergency service price agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc. (VS0000042761) for emergency debris monitoring services in estimated amount of \$525,000.00, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for emergency debris monitoring services related to the May 28, 2024, severe weather event, for a total estimated amount of \$750,000.00. If the service was bid on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to Tetra Tech, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Tetra Tech, Inc. under the Contract. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of \$750,000.00 (including the ratified amount of \$225,000.00), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Tetra Tech, Inc. from Service Price Agreement No. SAN-2024-00025272.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is according so resolved.
